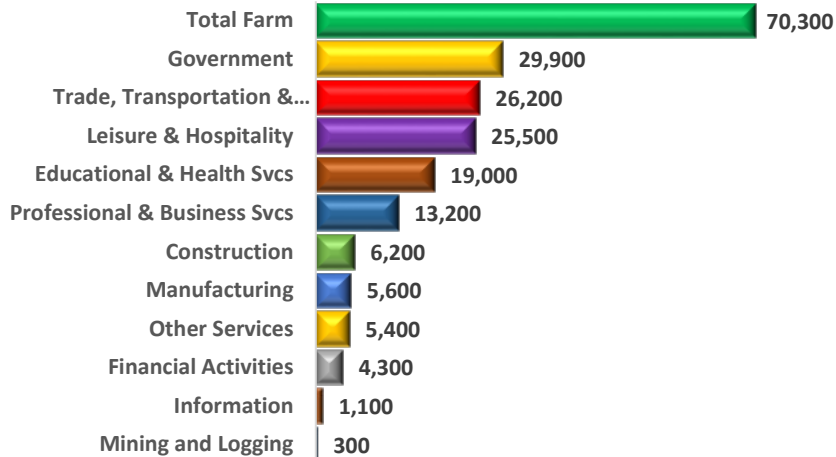

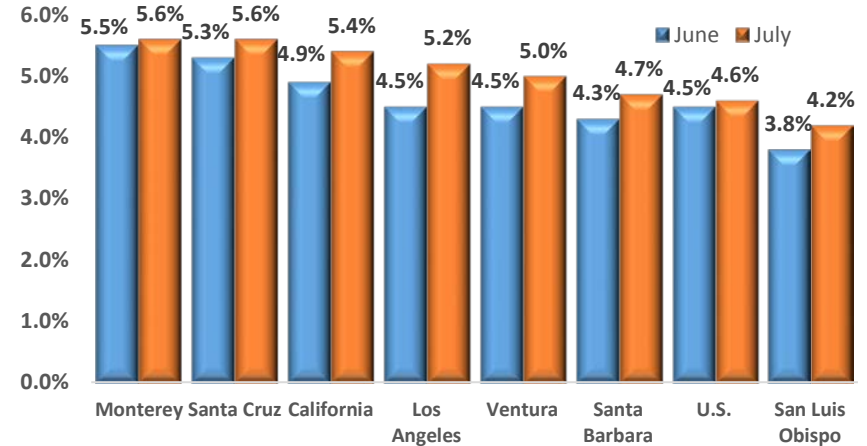
Industry Ranking by Employment Size

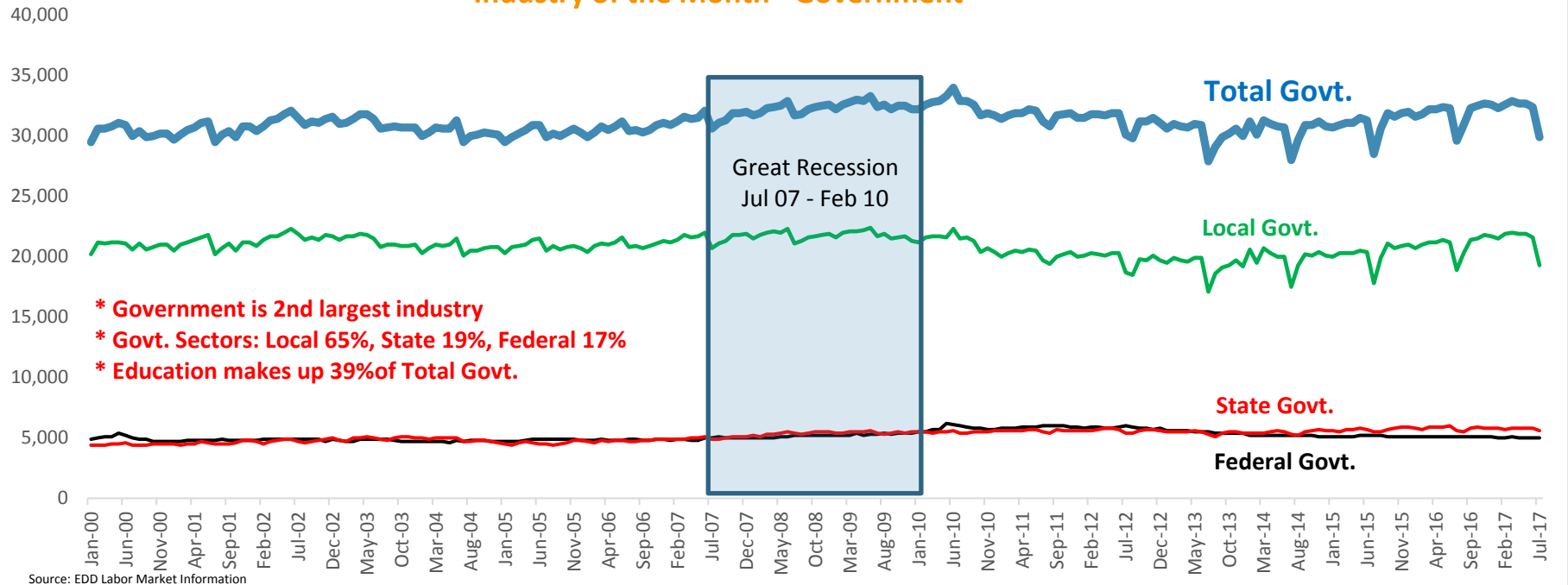
